## CHAPERONE RESPONSIBILITY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

One chaperone will be assigned to a maximum of 10 students and will be totally accountable for their conduct and behavior for the entire voyage.

Chaperones are responsible for ensuring their students abide by the following guidelines:

- No consumption of alcoholic beverages on board the vessel\*
- No entering the casinos or gambling\*
- No entering lounges designated for adults\*
- No disturbances in hallways or public areas.
- No abuse of physical property.
- Students under the age of 21 may not purchase alcoholic beverages on board the vessel.\*
- No use of illegal substances such as mind altering drugs.
- No abusive or offensive language may be used in public, to other guests, or vessel staff.
- Create excessive noise in cabins.
- No lascivious behavior

(\* Applies to minors only under the age of 21)

Each chaperone will ensure that his/her students (under the age of 18) abide by a 1:00 cabin curfew.

Each chaperone will be expected to maintain proper personal decorum at all times during the voyage.

If a chaperone fails to meet his/her responsibilities, the vessel's Group Coordinator shall issue a warning to that person. A second failure shall result in a warning from the vessel's hotel manager. A third failure shall be referred to the Master with a recommendation that the chaperone and the disruptive students be disembarked at the current port-of-call or the next port-of-call (if at sea). Return expenses shall be the responsibility of the group. If a Master considers an incident serious enough to justify immediate disembarkation, he may he may dispense with the issuing of warnings, in his sole discretion.
