I/We hereby give permission for the above named guest to participate in a group cruise on board the referenced ship. I/We understand and accept the conditions for our child to travel.

Furthermore, should my/our child require routine or emergency medical attention during the cruise, I specifically authorize the chaperone(s) for the named group to make any and all necessary parental decisions concerning any and all medical treatment that my/our child may require.

For the safety, security and enjoyment of all of our guests, the following rules must be followed:

- ♦ The legal drinking age onboard is 21 and is strictly enforced, including the purchase of drinks or bottles of liquor by adults for minors. Possession of alcohol by a minor will not be tolerated and any found will be confiscated (even if found in cabin).
- ♦ Purchase, possession, or consumption of drugs is illegal.
- ♦ No abusive or offensive language should be used to other guests or to staff and crew.
- ♦ Large radios ("boom boxes") are not permitted on board.
- ♦ Headphones must be used with radios on deck.
- ♦ No running in the hallways.
- ♦ No noise in cabin areas after 11 PM.
- ♦ Excessive disturbance on board the ship will also result in loss of damage/student guideline deposit
- ♦ Our shipboard credit program ("Sail & Sign") requires either a minimum \$100.00 cash deposit or a credit card, (American Express, Discover, VISA or Master card) IN THE GUEST'S OWN NAME, presented at check-in. Use of an account other than that of the traveling guest is prohibited by the credit card companies. The guest is responsible for keeping a positive cash balance (if applicable) at all times during the cruise. If there is an overage on the account, the guest is issued a check on board the morning of debarkation day with a copy of the final statement.

Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in the offender(s) losing their security deposit and if there is still a problem then he or she may be removed from the ship to make his or her own way home. Alternatively, the disruptive guest(s) may be detained in their stateroom for the duration of the voyage.

For senior classes, all guests under age 25 must pay a damage deposit of \$50.00 per person with their final payment. In the event of damage to the ship or property on board or if any costs are incurred as a result of inappropriate behavior, including excessive disturbance to other guests, charges for repairs or replacement or other costs incurred will be assessed against the entire group damage deposit.
